

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

### E. coli Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Iron River Sanitary District

We are required to monitor the well(s) supplying water to our system when routine compliance samples in the distribution system indicate a potential bacteria problem. Between 03/29/2022 and 04/04/2022, we did not monitor for *E. coli* bacteria in our well(s), and therefore cannot confirm that water from well(s) supplying the drinking water system were free from *E. coli* contamination during that time.

#### What precautions should be taken at this time?

There are no special precautions you need to take. If a situation arises where the water is not safe for human consumption, we will provide public notice within 24 hours.

#### What was the cause of the missed monitoring requirements?

Multiple, multiple samples have been required due to a persistent bacteria. This one sample was lost in the shuffle

#### What is being done to correct the problem?

The problem has already been addressed by many samples since the date.

#### When will the problem be resolved?

Resolution ~~is~~ already occurred. All testing is up to date and within compliance
